All Hands on Deck: United Parcel Service (UPS) Employees Volunteer for The Center for Family Resources

Marietta, GA (July 22, 2008) On Wednesday, July 23, United Parcel Service (UPS) employees will participate in a volunteer service project to benefit Cobb County families.

Through the Center for Family Resources, the employees, all from the UPS Public Relations Department, will perform improvement projects at the Cambridge Apartments complex including painting railing around tenant units. Additionally, the employees hosted a housing goods drive. The goods will support CFR's Adopt-An-Apartment initiative, an effort geared towards providing housing items for families entering the CFR Housing Program including items such as kitchen and bath items, bed linens, toiletries and hygiene items, etc.

The volunteer project is a part of the UPS United Way Campaign. The employees were charged with identifying an organization whose mission is aligned with the overarching goals of the United Way; including Safety, Non-Profit Effectiveness, Diversity and Economic and Global Literacy. This is the second year that UPS has chosen CFR has one of its beneficiaries.
